Competition in this List of Premiums is restricted to Members of the Society, except for Dogs and Home Produce. Light Horse Exhibitors have a Day Membership included in their class entry fee.

All stock must be the bona fide property of, and have been in the actual possession of, the Exhibitor before 1st April in the current year.

Prize money will be paid on the day, on production of the prize card awarded in the ring. Exhibitors should collect any prize money before 5pm from the Secretary's marquee on the main showfield, NOT from the Light Horse Secretary's tent.

All Regulations should be read before any entry form is completed and signed. Light Horse Exhibitors should be aware of both applicable Livestock Regulations, published in the Livestock Schedule, Catalogue and on the Website, as well as the Regulations contained within this specific Light Horse Schedule.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Judging times will vary depending on sections and rings. Please see the Horse & Pony timetable for approximate times. Sections being judged simultaneously will not be delayed under any circumstances.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter the times and format of classes, or to cancel any class, at its sole discretion.
3. The Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage which may arise from injury to any exhibit, either during the Show or during transit.
4. The Committee shall decide all questions respecting Premiums and other matters connected with the Show, and their decision given verbally by their Convenor, shall be final and not subject to any review whatever.
5. Stock for special or extra prizes is subject to the same Rules and Conditions as for any other prizes, excepting in this, that where Special Conditions are annexed to a special or extra prize, such special conditions shall prevail over the ordinary Rules and Regulations.
6. Every Lot must be intimated by a Certificate of Entry, together with the correct Entry Fee, and lodged with the Entries Secretary by the date shown on the front of this leaflet, or in accordance with Late Entries / Entries on the Day as indicated. Printed forms of entry to be had on application to the Secretary, or online through the show website www.westfifeshow.com.
7. All exhibits shall during the Show be in the charge of Exhibitors themselves, or Servants, and shall be placed in the Showground according to the directions of the Committee.
8. The decision of the Judges shall be final and not subject to review on any grounds whatever.
9. A protest can only be lodged on either or both of the following grounds;
 - i) That the exhibitor is not qualified to compete, or
 - ii) That the exhibitor is excluded by the Conditions or Rules of Competition.
10. Every protest must be made in writing and must be delivered during the Show at the Secretary's Office in the Showground. A deposit of £50 must be lodged with each protest and the Committee shall have power to withhold repayment if any expense has been incurred, or if they consider the protest unnecessary, or trivial.
11. On the second Tuesday after the Show, the parties to a protest must be in attendance at the Office of the Secretary of the Society at 7.30 pm with such evidence as to them may seem proper, when the protest will be disposed of by the Committee, whose decisions given verbally by their Convenor, shall be final, and not subject to any review whatever.
12. In the event of a Prize being awarded to an exhibit, against which it or its exhibitor a protest has been lodged and sustained, as provided in Rules 9, 10 and 11, such

prize shall be forfeited and shall be due to the exhibit (if any) which the Judges shall have found to be next in order of merit.

13. In no case shall a Premium be awarded unless the Judges shall deem the exhibit of sufficient merit.
14. All Horses and Ponies must be haltered and led.
15. The ages of all animals must be reckoned from 1st January in the year of birth, except where otherwise stated.
16. NO substitute entries will be accepted in Light Horse classes.
17. Ponies MUST NOT be left unattended tied to trailers/horse boxes.
18. A Riding Hat which complies with, or exceeds, the current standard must be worn at all times by mounted riders within the Showground.
19. **Cars accompanying horse boxes and wishing to park with them in the designated Horse Park will be charged £10.00.**
20. By signing the entry form, exhibitors accept that we will share their data, if necessary, with the bodies and breed societies listed in the schedule. Data will be published in our Show Catalogue, may be on the Society's website, and given to the local press with regards to the Show's results. The Society will maintain a database, reviewed annually, solely for the purpose of mailing Exhibitors and Members. This Show is a qualifying round for the **NPS Scotland Championship Final** to be held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.

NPS SCOTLAND RULES

1. Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final. Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section will not be allowed to enter the final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskays are not eligible.
3. Qualification in the M. & M In Hand Section may go to 3rd in the Championship. All others may go to no lower than 4th place.

4. **A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard**
5. **Closing Dates for Entries: Competitors qualifying at Shows held before Monday 4th June 2018 must send their qualifying cards and entries in by Thursday 28th June 2018. Shows after 5th June 2018 must adhere to a closing date of 1st August 2018 and Late Entries will NOT be accepted.**
6. **Cavesson nosebands are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden classes.**
7. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form.
8. The OWNER must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
9. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.
10. In Mountain and Moorland classes, riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D), riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
11. A child must have attained their twelfth birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge a pony at an NPS show, except for stallions, where the age will be the same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion.
12. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over.
13. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 and under, must wear a correctly secured skull cap / riding hat, that meets the current standards.
14. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.

SHETLAND PONY STUD BOOK SOCIETY Affiliation Rules 2018

1. Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals).
2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged two years and over must display a stallion disc.
3. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under

12 years old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

HIGHLAND PONY SOCIETY YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP

1. This show is a qualifier for the 2018 Highland Pony Society Youngstock Championship.
2. The Champion youngster across classes 449 and 450 will qualify for the Highland Pony Youngstock Championships to be held on 2 September 2018 at Strathallan Castle, Perthshire or on 14 October 2018 at Adlington Equestrian Centre, Cheshire.
3. Only pure bred registered Highland ponies may enter.
4. Exhibitors are not required to be members of the Highland Pony Society.

BRITISH SHOW PONY SOCIETY (BSPS) Affiliation – 18/005

BSPS QUALIFIERS

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S."), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

BSPS Rule 23: Ponies must be registered before the date of the Show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the championship they qualify for.

BSPS Rule 28: Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered with the B.S.P.S. before the date of the show at which they qualify for the B.S.P.S. Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This rule does not apply to classes with R.I.H.S. or OLYMPIA qualification.

516. This show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Challenge** - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Int. SRT, SH, WH, and Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP. Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any B.S.P.S. affiliated Show and competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must **NOT** have qualified for the 2017 Horse of The Year Show in the appropriate class.

517. This show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Premier League**. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the Lead Rein and First Ridden, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, Lead Rein Hunter Type, 122cms, 133cms, 143cm and 153cms Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, 133cms, 143cms and 153cms Working Hunter Pony, Intermediate Show Riding, Show Hunter and Working Hunter classes and the Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden Small, A & B & C & D's and Large Breeds and the Open Heritage WHP classes, and 1st to 4th in Mixed Height Open Classes will qualify.

519. This Show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Champion of Champions**. The Champion Mini Show Pony, the Champion Mini WHP, The Champion Open Show Pony, The Champion Open WHP/WH, the Champion Open SHP and the Champion Open Intermediate will qualify. In mixed height classes the first prize winner will qualify.

521. This show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Best Rider of the Year**. The Best Rider in the Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Lead rein Hunter Type, 128cms, 138cms and 148cms Show Pony, the 122cms, 133cms 143cms and 153cms SHP, the Cradle and Nursery Stakes, the 133cms, 143cms and 153cms WHP, the Intermediate Show Riding Type, Show Hunter, Working Hunter classes and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Ridden and WHP classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the B.S.P.S. Summer Championship Show.

524. This Show is a qualifier for the **2017 B.S.P.S. Championships Show**, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st and 2nd prize-winners only in classes (State the Class numbers), and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize-winners in the Open Intermediates S.R.T. (including Mixed Height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S. will qualify. In MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championship Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with **Rules 23 and 28** and ridden by a B.S.P.S. member.

BLAIR CASTLE WORKING HUNTER PONY SERIES

Run under BSPS Rules. Classes 436 - 438 are qualifiers for these Championships. Ponies placed 1st to 4th in the qualifying classes will qualify for the Championships held at Blair Castle International Horse Trials & Country Fair on Thursday 24th August 2017. Qualification may go down to 6th place if higher placed ponies have previously qualified.

BRITISH HORSE SOCIETY

STEWARTS BUILDING SERVICES/BHS SCOTLAND WORKING HUNTER SERIES 2018

Maximum height of jumps - 3ft 6ins; maximum spread - 3ft 9ins. Class 402 is a qualifier. The first **three** qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to 4th place provided the 4th placed rider jumped clear. To be eligible for the final, to be held in August 2018 at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair, either the rider or the owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS. This competition series is run under Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain (SHB (GB) the governing body of all hunter and sports horse's classes). It is the responsibility of organisers and competitors to be familiar with these rules; they can be found at www.sporthorsegb.co.uk **Please be aware of rule number 48 H which states: All ridden hunters must be shod all round. No pads or surgical shoes are allowed.**

There is no 2nd round, each show has the same qualifying status.

Open to members and non-members. However, **only Members may go forward to the Championship of the day.** VHS Membership to be applied for no later than 1 week prior to this show, to avoid disappointment.

VHS Scottish Supreme (Pre-Judging) Final qualification. ONLY MEMBERS placed 1st to 2nd in each age category will go to the Veteran Championship of the Day. In all classes - if

competitors placed 1st or 2nd are not Members qualification will be given to 3rd & 4th providing they are Members. Qualification will not go lower than 4th place. If the Champion or Reserve has qualified then 2nd or 3rd reserve may take qualification.

All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

Champions and Reserve both In-hand and Ridden must have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. This will qualify through the pre-judging of the Supreme. A Blue card entry will be given by the judge to complete and return to VHS Head Office, with the relevant entry fee. Should the Championship be combined the top 2 ridden and top 2 in-hand go forward.

This Show is a qualifier and every horse & pony placed 1st and 2nd in all In-Hand, Ridden Showing classes and Working Hunter Pony classes will qualify to compete in any appropriate class at the Finals. Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line. Qualification is for the Horse and Pony except for Young Handler classes, where the Handler qualifies. All qualified horses and ponies will be listed on the Caledonian Showing Show's website www.caledonianchampionships.webs.com where you will also find a regularly updated list of qualifying shows as well as a wealth of other information.

401 NOVICE Working Hunter Mare or gelding 4 years and over, exceeding 15.0hh (153 cm) and not to have won more than £50.00 in Jumping competitions. Jumps not exceeding 2ft 9ins in height.

402 OPEN Working Hunter Stewarts Building Services / BHS Scotland Working Hunter Series 2018

Open to horses 15hh and over, 4 years old and over. Riders 18 years old or over.
The course: At least 8 and not more than 12 fences, with changes of direction, must be set in a ring large enough to permit jumping fluently at a fair hunting pace. Fences should be rustic or as natural as possible, not easily dislodged, of solid appearance, well filled and with shrubs as wings. Maximum height 3ft 6ins (1.05m), maximum spread 3ft 9ins (1.12m), except open ditch and water. The course **should be set at, or near, maximum** unless the judge considers the ground makes this unsafe. Normally at least one upright and one spread must be at maximum. The first three prize winners will qualify for the final even if they did not jump clear. The final will be held at Blair Castle in August 2018. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to fourth place provided they had a clear round in the jumping. To be eligible to compete at the final either the owner or rider of the horse must be a member of the BHS.
