PLEASE NOTE

Competition in this List of Premiums is restricted to Members of the Society, except for Dogs and Home Produce. Light Horse Exhibitors have a Day Membership included in their class entry fee.

All stock must be the bona fide property of, and have been in the actual possession of, the Exhibitor before 1st April in the current year.

Prize money will be paid on the day, on production of the prize card awarded in the ring. Exhibitors should collect any prize money before 5pm from the Secretary's marquee on the main showfield, NOT from the Light Horse Secretary's tent.

All Regulations should be read before any entry form is completed and signed. Light Horse Exhibitors should be aware of both applicable Livestock Regulations, published in the Livestock Schedule, Catalogue and on the Website, as well as the Regulations contained within this specific Light Horse Schedule.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Judging times will vary depending on sections and rings. Please see the Horse & Pony timetable for approximate times. Sections being judged simultaneously will not be delayed under any circumstances.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter the times and format of classes, or to cancel any class, at its sole discretion.
3. The Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage which may arise from injury to any exhibit, either during the Show or during transit. It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors have their own third party insurance cover.
4. The Committee shall decide all questions respecting Premiums and other matters connected with the Show, and their decision given verbally by their Convenor, shall be final and not subject to any review whatever.
5. Stock for special or extra prizes is subject to the same Rules and Conditions as for any other prizes, excepting in this, that where Special Conditions are annexed to a special or extra prize, such special conditions shall prevail over the ordinary Rules and Regulations.
6. Every Lot must be intimated by a Certificate of Entry, together with the correct Entry Fee, and lodged with the Entries Secretary by the date shown on the front of this leaflet, or in accordance with Late Entries / Entries on the Day as indicated. Printed forms of entry to be had on application to the Secretary, or online through the show website www.westfifeshow.com.
7. All exhibits shall during the Show be in the charge of Exhibitors themselves, or Servants, and shall be placed in the Showground according to the directions of the Committee.
8. The decision of the Judges shall be final and not subject to review on any grounds whatever.
9. A protest can only be lodged on either or both of the following grounds;
 - i) That the exhibitor is not qualified to compete, or
 - ii) That the exhibitor is excluded by the Conditions or Rules of Competition.
10. Every protest must be made in writing and must be delivered during the Show at the Secretary's Office in the Showground. A deposit of £50 must be lodged with each protest and the Committee shall have power to withhold repayment if any expense has been incurred, or if they consider the protest unnecessary, or trivial.
11. On the second Tuesday after the Show, the parties to a protest must be in attendance at the Office of the Secretary of the Society at 7.30 pm with such evidence as to them may seem proper, when the protest will be disposed of by the Committee, whose decisions given verbally by their Convenor, shall be final, and not subject to any review whatever.
12. In the event of a Prize being awarded to an exhibit, against which it or its exhibitor a

protest has been lodged and sustained, as provided in Rules 9, 10 and 11, such prize shall be forfeited and shall be due to the exhibit (if any) which the Judges shall have found to be next in order of merit.

13. In no case shall a Premium be awarded unless the Judges shall deem the exhibit of sufficient merit.
14. All Horses and Ponies must be haltered and led.
15. The ages of all animals must be reckoned from 1st January in the year of birth, except where otherwise stated.
16. NO substitute entries will be accepted in Light Horse classes.
17. Ponies MUST NOT be left unattended tied to trailers/horse boxes.
18. A Riding Hat which complies with, or exceeds, the current standard must be worn at all times by mounted riders within the Showground.
19. It is mandatory for all horses and ponies entering the Showground to be vaccinated against **Equine Influenza**, except foals under 6 months. All vaccinations must have been administered at least 7 days before the date of the show.
All animals must have completed the primary course of two vaccinations. If enough time has elapsed, the 3rd booster vaccination must have been administered. Please seek veterinary advice on the timing of vaccinations. **Further booster vaccinations must be administered at intervals of not more than 365 days.**
Random passport checks may be implemented and any animal without a current, valid vaccination protocol, or an owner / rider unable to produce a valid passport, will lead to immediate eviction from the Showground.
20. By signing the entry form, exhibitors accept that we will share their data, if necessary, with the bodies and breed societies listed in the schedule. Data will be published in our Show Catalogue, may be on the Society's website, and given to the local press with regards to the Show's results. The Society will maintain a database, reviewed annually, solely for the purpose of mailing Exhibitors and Members. Exhibitors do have the right to withdraw consent of this at any time by contacting the Secretary, 07849 279428 or secretary@westfifeshow.com.
21. Exhibitor tickets to access the show will be emailed to the address provided. Please ensure that your email address is entered clearly and correctly on the entry form, or online entry system. **Tickets must be pre-booked and/or pre-purchased – no tickets will be available at the gate on the day.** Tickets will be allocated on the basis of two tickets for the first animal entered and one further ticket for an additional animal. The maximum number of tickets issued per exhibitor will be three. Additional tickets are available to purchase online at the time of entry. **All children (under 14 on the day of the show) will be free but must be pre-booked.**

401 NOVICE Working Hunter Mare or gelding 4 years and over, exceeding 14.2hh (148 cm) and not to have won more than £50.00 in Jumping competitions. Rider 14 years old or over. Jumps not exceeding 2ft 9ins in height.

402 OPEN Working Hunter

Perth Equine Vets / BHS Scotland Working Hunter

Open to horses exceeding 14.2hh (148cm), 4 years old and over. The rider must be a member of the British Horse Society. Riders 18 years old or over on the day of the Finals. **The course:** At least 8 and not more than 12 fences, with changes of direction, must be set in a ring large enough to permit jumping fluently at a fair hunting pace. Fences should be rustic or as natural as possible, not easily dislodged, of solid appearance, well filled and with shrubs as wings. Maximum height 3ft 6ins (1.05m), maximum spread 3ft 9ins (1.12m), except open ditch and water. The course **should be set at, or near, maximum** unless the judge considers the ground makes this unsafe. Normally at least one upright and one spread must be at maximum.

Qualification: The first **THREE** will qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to fourth place provided the 4th placed rider jumped clear. If a class has less than four entries, only the winner will qualify for the final. The final will be held at

Blair Castle in August 2022.

- Only pure bred registered Highland youngstock; foals, 1, 2 and 3yrs olds may enter.
- Two Championships will be held; one at Central Scotland Highland Pony Club - Summer Show, Strathallan Castle, Auchterarder PH3 1JZ on Sunday 4th September 2022 and one at the Great British In Hand Show at Kelsall Hill EC on Saturday 17th September 2022. The qualifying exhibitor can select which Championship Show they wish to enter.
- Exhibitors are not required to be members of the Highland Pony Society for qualifying classes. However, all those competing in the Championships must be members of the Society.
- Entry to the Championships is free.
- At the Youngstock Championships, the Champions and Reserves will receive rosettes and prize money of £100 and £50 respectively and all those forward at the finals will receive £15 and a finalist rosette. A sash and perpetual trophy will be awarded to each of the Champions.

BSPS QUALIFIERS

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S."), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

BSPS Rule 5: Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS, are allowed seven working days in which to become members and register their ponies. N.B. This Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, OLYMPIA or Blue Riband qualification.

BSPS Rule 21: Ponies must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the BSPS Summer and Winter Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before, who are allowed seven days in which to become members and register their ponies. (See Rule 5)

BSPS Rule 49A: Body protectors MUST be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes, including practice ring at BSPS Affiliated shows. Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practice Jumps) and the jumping phase in all BSPS organised and affiliated events.

516. This show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. 'Classic Services Group' Challenge**. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH, and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

519. This Show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Binks Family Champion of Champions**. The 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify:- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Ponies, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open RHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH and Heritage WHP classes.

521. This show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. 'Black Country Saddles' Best Rider Competition**, for riders 25 years and under. Please contact BSPS Sawtry for further information.

524. This Show is a qualifier for the **B.S.P.S. Championships Show**. The 1st and 2nd prize-winners only in the following classes qualify; Open Lead Rein, Open First Ridden, Open 128, 138 and 148cm Show Ponies, Open 122, 133, 143 & 153cm SHP. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize-winners in the Open Intermediate classes (including Mixed Height Intermediate) will qualify. W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S. and Heritage Classes will qualify. In MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify.

BSPS SCOTLAND MEMBERS CHAMPION OF THE YEAR

This Show is a qualifier for The BSPS Scotland Members Champion of the Year competition to be held at BSPS Scotland Finale Show on the 3rd September 2022. 1st prize winners in the Lead Rein and First Ridden Show Pony, Pony of Hunter Type, Heritage M&M classes, Open Show Pony, Open Pony of Show Hunter Type, Open Intermediate SRT and SHT classes will qualify. In the event of the 1st placed winner at this show having already qualified for the BSPS Scotland Members Champion of the Year, the qualification will be the highest placed BSPS Scottish Member (not already qualified), from the first THREE ponies placed in each class. The rider/pony combination who qualify in each section must BOTH hold BSPS Scotland Memberships, qualification will be subject to written confirmation from BSPS Scotland.

BRITISH HORSE SOCIETY

Perth Equine Vets / BHS SCOTLAND WORKING HUNTER

Maximum height of jumps - 3ft 6ins; maximum spread - 3ft 9ins. Class 402 is a qualifier. The first **three** qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to 4th place provided the 4th placed rider jumped clear. To be eligible for the final, to be held in August 2022 at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials and Country Fair, the rider of the horse must be a member of the BHS.

This competition is run under Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain (SHB (GB) the governing body of all hunter and sports horse's classes). It is the responsibility of organisers and competitors to be familiar with these rules; they can be found at www.sporthorsegb.co.uk **Please be aware of rule number 51 H which states: All ridden hunters must be shod all round. No pads or surgical shoes are allowed.**
